**FIRST RESPONDERS COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP
for Children of Full-Time First Responders**

As a school whose mission it is to inspire citizenship in its students, Independence is proud to support those who are inspired to serve as first responders for our community. Students who have one or both parents who work full-time as first responders in law enforcement, fire protection and/or in a capacity as an emergency medical technician (EMT) are eligible to receive a discount of \$6,000 toward tuition during each year of enrollment.

Since Independence was founded in 1978, the school has placed an emphasis on learning, leadership and citizenship through both its mission and program. First responders who elect to help others are exceptional citizens and positive role models for our students.

Parents are also welcome to apply for financial assistance through the Independence Tuition Assistance Program (TAP) and may apply for available scholarships. Applicants must complete the standard admission process and meet our criteria for admission in order to be eligible.
