NOVELS

Each year, students engage in novel studies for language arts, science, and/or social studies. These lessons offer a rich opportunity for exploring authentic literature and for discussing and integrating varied topics. Students may be called to describe themes, identify main characters, find various structural elements

such as compound sentences or similes, as well as learn new vocabulary. We would like the students to have the freedom to mark their books as a means of study. For example, key words may be highlighted and chapters may be summarized.

As a matter of practicality, **a fee of \$20 is collected from each student to cover the cost of the novels that will be ordered throughout the year.** The remainder of the costs associated with the novels is supplemented by the school. Please make checks payable to **The Independence School.**
