## Supply List (2018-2019)

### **GRADE 4**

- 7 plastic 2-pocket folders: 1 red, 1 yellow, 1 green, 1 blue, 1 orange, 2 different choice folders
- 1 composition book
- Spiral notebooks: 1 single subject (orange), 1 three subject (green), 2 two subject (yellow, blue)
- Erasable pens (blue or black)
- 1 red pen
- Pencils with erasers and a small sharpener
- 2 Highlighters
- 2 reams of wide-ruled notebook paper (**keep one at home**)
- 1 soft, zipper pencil case for pens and pencils
- 1 box of broad-tipped colored markers (8)
- 1 box of thin-tipped colored markers (8)
- 1 box of colored pencils (8-16)
- 1 small box of crayons (8-24)
- 1 pair of scissors (7-inch Fiskars work well. Please label)
- 1 **YELLOW** legal pad (8.5"x11")

- 3 3"x3" Post-it note pads

### NOVELS

Each year, students engage in novel studies for language arts, science, and/or social studies. These lessons offer a rich opportunity for exploring authentic literature and for discussing and integrating varied topics. Students may be called to describe themes, identify main characters, find various structural elements

such as compound sentences or similes, as well as learn new vocabulary. We would like the students to have the freedom to mark their books as a means of study. For example, key words may be highlighted and chapters may be summarized.
