Dear Parents of **Rising** 2nd-4th Grade Students,

As the students are winding down and preparing to enjoy their last days of this school year, we are looking ahead. Research shows that most students lose 2-3 months of grade-level math over the summer if they do not review. That is why we have a summer math program.

There are two parts to this summer work: Part 1 (Math) and Part 2 (100 Minute Fact Fluency). Before the end of the school year, your child will have a chance to go onto www.mobymax.com/ in school and try some assignments, giving him or her familiarity with the site. Individual user names and passwords for *MobyMax* will go home with your child during the last week of school.

Please see the information below to learn how the program works.

PART 1 – MATH: Begins June 9 and is completed by September 5.

- Students will complete the 8 lessons established by their teacher in *MobyMax – MATH* that are a review of the skills learned this year. Each lesson has multiple topics within it to complete. You will only see **one** lesson at a time with its related topics.

For example, this lesson, "Adding with Tens," has four topics that have to be completed to move to the next lesson.



Part 2 – 100 Minute FACT FLUENCY: Begins June 9 and is completed by September 5.

- Students will also complete 100 minutes of fact practice with *MobyMax – FACT FLUENCY*.

- We recommend that students complete this time over a series of small sessions. Students who “mastered” all of the facts (all of the boxes would be shaded - see below) **will continue to practice for improved speed until they reach 100 minutes.**

Since summer math is required, students who complete the requirements will receive a summer math grade.

- Completed summer math work = A 100%
 - 80 points for all 8 MATH lessons completed (10 points per lesson)
 - 20 points for 100 minutes of Fact Fluency practice (1 point per 5 minutes)

The goal, of course, is to do the summer math so that learning stays strong. The use of grades is designed to reward students for doing the summer math. - **What's in the baggie?**

Students going into grades 2 and 3 received a baggie with some materials to help them with their math: a number line, a set of ones, tens and hundreds cards, and a hundred chart.

- **How can I help my child learn math facts that are difficult for him/her?**

When there are math facts that your child has not yet mastered, write those down. Pick just two or three facts to practice each week when off line. More than that at one time can be too much. Intersperse the practice with non-math work or play, and don't forget to make it fun. Here are some sites for non-flashcard math fact games.
